- Be an owner or blood descendant of an original owner of a Tuwharetoa Land Block as set down by Judge Davies 20 July 1964.
- Be registered on the roll of beneficiaries of the Tuwharetoa Maori Trust Board.
- Send with applications copies of land blocks which can be obtained by contacting the Maori Land Court, The Lake Taupo Forest Trust or by going to www.maorilandonline
- Send in applications and all necessary information before the closing date
- Send a verified deposit slip

IMPORTANT INFORMATION:

- Late applications will not be considered after the closing date.
- The office requires the original application.
- It is the responsibility of the individual to ensure that the office receives the application.
- Scholarship applications must be signed by the applicant applying for the grant.
- All information requested is a standard policy of the Board and is required each year

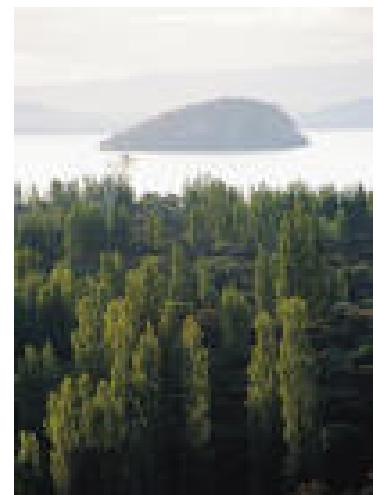

(Appendix II) EDUCATION GRANTS:

Made by the Trust Board come from the Board's half share of Lake Taupo fishing licence sales, in accordance with the Maori Land Amendment and Maori Land Claims Amendment Act 1926, and the Maori Trust Boards Act 1955. For a Trust Board beneficiary to be eligible for a grant, he/she must be the NATURAL ISSUE of an ORIGINAL OWNER of the Ngati Tuwharetoa blocks of land adjoining Lake Taupo and its tributaries prior to 1926 when the titles of the bed of the lake and tributaries passed in to Crown ownership.

(Appendix III)

The following category of persons is NOT ELIGIBLE for the Board's grants:

1. A person who purchased an interest in land adjoining Lake Taupo or its tributary rivers and streams, either before 1926 or after this date and who is not an original owner or the natural issue of an original owner.
2. A person who obtained an interest in land adjoining Lake Taupo or its tributary rivers and streams by way of a gift of that land or a legacy from a Will and who is not an original owner or the natural issue of an original owner.
3. An adopted person who is not an original owner or the natural issue of an original owner.
